Make sure you've got everything you need for a weekend outdoors! Temperatures can drop as low as 13°C/55°F at night—but check the weather too. Pack light, Campers.

THINGS TO BRING

- Your ticket
- Your photo ID
- Cold-weather sleeping bag or heavy blankets
- Pillows
- Tent supplies for BYOT campers
- Lake and bath towels
- Sweatshirts and jeans (for those chilly nights)
- Light jacket, rain jacket, poncho, waterproof anorak, etc. (you never know when a rain shower might roll through)
- Athletic wear
- A hat
- Bathing suits (plus plastic bags to pack when they're wet)
- Comfortable sneakers
- Extra socks
- Wellies or rain boots
- An umbrella
- Toiletries
- Tissues
- Hand sanitizer
- Bug spray
- Sunscreen
- Sunglasses
- A refillable water bottle
- Yoga mat, athletic equipment, etc.
- A flashlight or headlight
- Flip flops for the shower
- A positive attitude
- UK power converter
- White shirts, socks, and bandanas for tie dying

Keep in mind that Camp does have some no-nos. Bring any of these and you'll be turned away at the gate.

THINGS TO LEAVE

- Professional cameras or recording devices
- Large stereo systems
- Valuables
- Glass

- Gas canisters, propane or butane cylinders, or nitrous oxide
